Respect, Responsibility, Reasoning and Resilience.

- **Responsibility** – I am accountable for my actions and I take a stand when I feel something is wrong.
- **Reasoning** – I question what is real.
- **Resilience** – I get back up from tough situations.

We ask that all families talk about internet safety and discuss how children are using the 4R's. By working together, we can make the internet safer for everyone.
