Congratulations Thomas

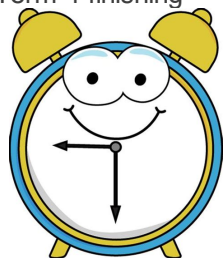


Congratulations Thomas for raising the most money in the school for the Day For Daniel Fun Run. He raised over \$500! Well done, Thomas.
