About the Program:

A Better Way (ABW):

Is a community-based program that works directly with Aboriginal and Non-Aboriginal* fathers who use controlling behaviours and/or violence against their family.

Has adopted cultural healing approaches specifically designed for Aboriginal fathers and families.

Further assists and supports fathers in developing positive parenting relationships with their children.

Offers fathers a flexible and individualised, tailored treatment approach.

Addresses family violence to increase the safety and well-being for their children and families.

Is a 1:1 family violence, trauma-informed approach that is underpinned by the Safe & Together ™ model.

The ABW Referral Criteria is:

- Any report of Family Violence (Intimate Partner) in the last 6 months
- Preferably the Father is having contact with his children (living with, access or phone contact)
- Preferably the Mother (non-offending parent) is having contact with the Father (living together or through access arrangements)
- Mother (non-offending parent) must be willing to have some contact with the program
- Father needs to be willing and prepared to work on changing their family violence behaviours.
- Fathers need to live within the Bayside Peninsula and Casey Cardinia area
